Article VII, Section III: Clubs desiring to Co-Host must:

- 1) submit a written request of their proposal and
- 2) have a club representative attend the board meeting at which that club representative will present the written proposal.

 3) Such proposals must be submitted to the Secretary-Treasurer at least six months prior to the commencement date of the Convention referred to therein.

 4) Proposals to host a Convention may be accepted prior to the six month period or at any special meeting or telephone conference as well.

 5) A Member Club may co-host such Conventions only once during any three-year period, unless the Board approves otherwise.

 6) (Section IV): Host clubs will perform such duties as described in the Convention Manual

- 7) (Section VIII): All host clubs will follow the rules, suggestions, etc., contained within the Convention Manual of the Society along with the directions of the convention coordinator.

I hereby resign from the position of Secretary and YN Program Chairman of the Michigan State Numismatic Society effective December 31, 2018. As it would be a conflict with my new career with Heritage Auctions and Galleries.
